Philippians 4:4-8, 13 (Amplified)

- 4 Rejoice in the Lord Always! Delight, gladden yourselves in Him! Again I say – rejoice!
- 5 Let all people know and perceive and recognize your unselfishness, your considerateness, your forbearing spirit. The Lord is near – He is coming soon.
- 6 Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything by prayer and petition (definite requests), and with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God.
- 7 And God’s peace be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace which transcends all understanding, shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. For the rest, brothers and sisters,

- Whatever is worthy of reverence and is honorable and seemly ..
Whatever is just ...

If there is any virtue and excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think on and weight and take account of these things – fix your mind on them!
- 13 I have strength for all things in Christ, Who empowers me. I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me, that is ...
I am self-sufficient in Christ’s sufficiency!

New Worlds Are as Close as Your Mind

Philippians 4:4-13 (see other side)

Introduction

- Our God-given human mind has amazing powers to influence and control us! Examples.
- We need to get Biblical insights on the importance of healthy thinking.

I. There is an old way we try to endure in this world all on our own! (Galatians 5:19, 22)

- A. The Old way is one of impurity of the mind
1. The un-spiritual mind (Colossians 2:18)
 2. The un-clean mind (Titus 1:15)
 3. The un-committed mind (Romans 1:28)
 4. The un-productive mind (Ephesians 4:17)
- B. The old Way leads to the impossible life!
1. A life of doubting everyone!
 2. A life of debating everything!
 3. A life of deflated feelings!
 4. A life of defeat!
- C. Is there anything worth committing my life to?

II. There is a new day of JOY! When we live our life each day with Christ!

- A. Like Paul, we too have resources of JOY!
1. Accepting our imprint of divinity (Genesis 1:27)
 2. Accepting our limitations of humanity (Phil 2:7)
 3. Accepting our liberty to choose (Joshua 24:15)
 4. Accepting our unity as one in Christ (Eph 4:4)
- B. Like Paul, the results for us too can be JOY!
1. Joy and the place I’m in (Philippians 1:18)
 2. Joy and the people I’m with (Philippians 1:15)
 3. Joy and the person I am (Philippians 3:7)
 4. Joy and the problems I confront (Philippians 4:4)
- C. The peace of God shall keep our minds and hearts through Christ Jesus! (Philippians 1:28, 4:7)

***Therefore, if any person be in Christ, he/she is a new creature!
Old things have passed away! Behold, all things are become new!***

2 Corinthians 5:17
