Are We Just Talking to Ourselves?

Colossians 4:2-6

²Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.

³And pray for us too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.

⁴Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.

⁵Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders: make the most of every opportunity.

⁶Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

Four Principles for Effective Evangelism

Principle One

Exposure

- “Proclaim”
- Not Isolation
- Expose people to the Gospel where they are

Principle Two

Clear Articulation

- Forget about the doublespeak
- Talk about who Jesus is, who you are and why you need Him!
- You plant the seed, someone else waters it, then God closes the deal.

Principle Three

Listening

- Often we don’t listen for the questions
- Relate Jesus as the answer
- Pray for God to show us the “open door”

Principle Four

Lifestyle

- Be realistic
- Be relational
- Be responsible
