Wendy helps the Baptist Community of Congo train pastors at the Bible Institute in Kimpese. She also works with an interdisciplinary team on HIV/AIDS awareness and prevention, especially among Congo's youth and young adults. This offering also supports **Anita & Rick Gutierrez**, missionaries to **South Africa**. They are physicians who serve in Durban. They work with the Baptist Mission of South Africa, a group that traces its roots to American Baptist work in South India. Anita and Rick train both community healthcare workers and church leaders, with a special focus on HIV/AIDS education and care. (We will receive this offering through the month of October. Our goal for this year is \$2,190.00. As of Sunday, October 19th, we have received \$720.00.)
