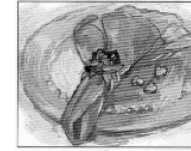

## MULTIPLE CHOICE TEST

1. Give what is left over in your budget each month. Thousands of people do it this way. See what's left over at the end of the month, then give some to God.

6. Give a portion of whatever God has made available for you to have and serve as steward and manager of for Him. Use the tithe (tenth) as a guide. Be ready for the blessings God will send your way!
