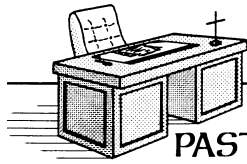

Marriage Communication Guidelines

1. Be a ready listener and do not answer until the other person has finished talking. (Proverbs 18:13; James 1:19)
2. Be slow to speak. Think first. Don't be hasty in your words. Speak in such a way that the other person can understand and accept what you have to say. (Proverbs 15:23 & 28; 21:23; 29:20; James 1:19)
3. Speak the truth always, but do it in love. Do not exaggerate. (Ephesians 4:15 & 25; Colossians 3:9)
4. Do not use silence to frustrate the other person. Explain why you are hesitant to talk at this time.
5. Do not become involved in quarrels. It is possible to disagree without quarrelling. (Proverbs 7:14; 20:3; Romans 13:13; Ephesians 4:31)
6. Do not respond in anger. Use soft and kind responses. (Proverbs 14:29; 15:1; 25:15; 29:11; Ephesians 4:26 & 31)
7. When you are in the wrong, admit it and ask for forgiveness. (James 5:16) When someone confesses to you, tell them you forgive them. Be sure it is forgotten and not brought up to the person. (Proverbs 17:9; Ephesians 4:32; Colossians 3:13; 1 Peter 4:8)
8. Avoid nagging. (Proverbs 10:19; 17:9; 20:5)
9. Do not blame or criticize the other person. Instead, restore ... encourage ... build up. If someone verbally attacks, criticizes or blames you, do not respond in the same manner. (Romans 12:17 & 21; 1 Peter 2:23; 3:9)
10. Try to understand the other person's opinion. Make allowances for differences. Be concerned about their interests. (Philippians 2:1-4)

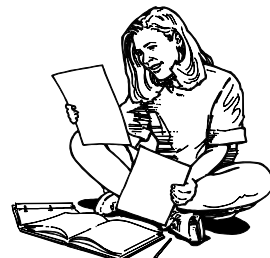

AMERICAN BAPTIST CHURCHES OF THE CENTRAL REGION SCHOLARSHIP

The ABC/CR offers an "Opportunity Scholarship" to encourage lifelong learning. Two \$1,000 scholarships are awarded each spring. This is a general scholarship to encourage higher education (beyond high school). It is a one year award, and students who wish to be considered for an additional year must reapply.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must be a member of an American Baptist church of the central region, have written support from their pastor or another church leader who is not a relative and apply before March 15th. To receive an application, contact the church office.
